Apitourism

Apitourism is an alternative form of tourism linked to the art of beekeeping and the life of the bee.

The story about the bee and the synergies of nature, which can be transmitted within a natural landscape in a unique way by a beekeeper, creates an authentic tourist product.

Visiting an apiary, observing the honey bee colonies in their natural environment, honey tasting, candle making workshops, apitherapy, walks in bee friendly gardens, are some of the activities of apitourism.



Full Day programme briefly:

- Meet up & Introduction / professional facility tour, learn about bees
- Suit up & hive inspection
- Questions, photos, honey and honeycomb tasting
- Lunch
- Workshops



Meeting and introduction to the world of bees – learn about bees, how honey is made and how to stay safe when handling bees. Facility visit, honey bottling, Interactive question game and walk through the gardens where we learn about beekeeping flowers and trees

You are now beekeepers for a day and will do an inspection which includes - locating
the queen, explaining and observing brood at different stages, drone/bee
differences, pollen, honey.**
